
June Meeting Minutes

at the Golden Corral Restaurant, 6865 N. Thornydale, Tucson, Arizona.



Ken and Heidi Farr's Tweetie made the trip with flying colors - mostly YELLOW!






# Lakewood shows up at the Mt Graham Observatory to treat staff to some Eye Candy
