DEC. '91



Dave's opening comments reported on the difficult automatic transmission problem in his '67 Corvair Coupe which was hard to diagnose. DON CHASTAIN was able to determine the problem utilizing another automatic transmission Dave had. Now the car runs like a charm.

Minutes of the October meeting as published were approved.
