





Ice Cream Social

If you can't take your sweet time making an ice cream treat, you've come to the right place. Each of the recipes on this page requires only 30 minutes or less to prepare, and only one needs to be frozen before it can be served.

CANTALOUPE A LA MODE

—Nancy Walker, Granite City, Illinois

- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1 teaspoon grated lemon peel
- 1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries
- 2 small cantaloupe, halved and seeded
- 4 scoops vanilla ice cream

Fresh mint, optional

In a saucepan, combine the first five ingredients; bring to a boil over medium heat. Boil and stir for 2 minutes. Add blueberries and heat through. Fill cantaloupe with ice cream; top with sauce. Garnish with mint if desired. Yield: 4 servings (1 cup sauce).

DIRTY ICE CREAM

—Nora Troyer, Franklin, Kentucky

- 2 quarts vanilla ice cream, softened
- 1 package (16 ounces) cream-filled chocolate sandwich cookies, crushed
- 1 carton (8 ounces) frozen whipped topping, thawed

Additional cookies, halved and/or crushed, optional

Fresh mint, optional

In a large bowl, combine ice cream and cookies. Fold in whipped topping. Pour into an ungreased 13-in. x 9-in. x 2-in. pan. Cover and freeze overnight. Remove from freezer 10 minutes before serving. Garnish with additional cookies and mint if desired. Yield: 16-20 servings.

HOT APPLE SUNDAES

—Delia Gurnow, New Madrid, Missouri

- 1 can (21 ounces) apple pie filling
 - 1/4 cup apple juice
 - 1 tablespoon sugar
 - 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- Vanilla ice cream

In a saucepan, combine the first four

ingredients. Cook and stir over medium heat until heated through. Serve over ice cream. Yield: 2 cups.

EASY HOT FUDGE SAUCE

—Nancy Nielson, Cambridge, Ohio

- 2 squares (1 ounce each) unsweetened chocolate
- 1 can (14 ounces) sweetened condensed milk
- 1/4 to 1/3 cup milk

Place all ingredients in a heavy saucepan; cook and stir over medium heat until chocolate is melted. Serve warm. Store in the refrigerator. Yield: 1-1/2 cups.

BLUEBERRY MILK SHAKE

Mount Ulla, North Carolina

- 1 cup milk
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 1 pint vanilla ice cream
- 1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries
- 1 tablespoon sugar
- 1 tablespoon grated lemon peel

Place all ingredients in a blender container; cover and process on high until smooth. Pour into glasses. Refrigerate any leftovers. Yield: 3-4 servings.

THICK CHOCOLATE SHAKE

- 1 cup milk
- 1/2 cup instant chocolate drink mix
- 3 cups vanilla ice cream

- 1 carton (8 ounces) strawberry yogurt

- 1/4 cup butter or margarine, softened
- 6 frozen waffles, lightly toasted
- 6 scoops butter pecan ice cream or flavor of your choice

In a small bowl, combine the first three ingredients; mix well. Spread over waffles. Broil for 3-4 minutes or until bubbly. Top with ice cream. Yield: 6 servings.

ORANGE-GLAZED BANANAS

- 3/4 cup orange juice concentrate
 - 3 tablespoons butter or margarine
 - 3 tablespoons brown sugar
 - 2 tablespoons grated orange peel
 - 3/4 teaspoon ground ginger
 - 4 medium firm bananas, sliced
- Vanilla ice cream

In a saucepan over medium heat, combine the first five ingredients. Cook and stir until the sugar is dissolved. Add bananas and heat through. Serve over ice cream. Yield: about 3 cups.
