

CANTALOUPE A LA MODE

- 1/2 cup water
- 1/2 cup sugar
 - 2 tablespoons lemon juice
 - 1 tablespoon cornstarch
 - 1 teaspoon grated lemon peel
 - 1 cup fresh or frozen blueberries
 - 2 small cantaloupe, halved and seeded
- 4 scoops vanilla ice cream Fresh mint, optional

In a saucepan, combine the first five ingredients; bring to a boil over medium heat. Boil and stir for 2 minutes, Add blueberries and heat through. Fill cantaloupe with ice cream, top with sauce, Garnish with mint il desired. Yield: 4 servings (1 cup sauce).

DIRTY ICE CREAM

- 2 quarts vanilla ice cream, softened
- 1 package (16 ounces) creamfilled chocolate sandwich cookies, crushed
